Help your 4-year-old prepare for school!

WHY PRE-K?

Pre-K helps children develop stronger reading, writing, math, English, listening, and social skills. Research shows that children who attend Pre-K are more likely to graduate from high school and succeed as adults!

WHO QUALIFIES?

To qualify for FREE all-day Pre-K, your child must be at least 4 years old by September 1, 2018 and meet ANY of the following criteria:

- ✓ Child is from a low-income household
- ✓ Child is unable to speak English well
- ✓ Child is homeless
- ✓ Child has been in foster care
- ✓ Child's parent is a member of the U.S. Armed Forces

WHAT TO BRING?

- Child's official birth certificate
- Child's up-to-date immunization records
- Child's social security card (if available)
- Proof of address (utility bill or lease)
- Parent/guardian photo ID
- Income verification (current pay stub, SNAP letter, or W-2 form)
- Military qualifiers (parent military ID)
- Foster child qualifiers (Pre-K eligible letter from DFPS)
