DISTRICT PERFORMANCE OVERVIEW

The Academic Excellence Indicator System (AEIS) was mandated by the Texas Legislature to emphasize student achievement as the basis for accreditation of local school districts. The State Board of Education established performance standards for several academic and achievement variables. In addition to the state performance, Vidor ISD's performance is compared to all of the districts within our State Education Service Center, Region 5.

One purpose of this report is to assist districts and campuses in reviewing their Strategic Plans and modifying them as needed based on the performance information contained in the report.

The academic and achievement variables included in the comparison are the TAKS scores, attendance rate, annual dropout rate, completion of advanced courses, and college admission tests (SAT and ACT). Results for Vidor ISD, the State and Region 5 are included.

The TAKS Scores reported in AEIS include only test takers who were enrolled in the district as of the last Friday in the previous October. This means that a student who moved into the district a week before the TAKS was given would not be included in the count for that district or campus. This is referred to as the "October Subset".

TEXAS ASSESSMENT OF KNOWLEDGE & SKILLS

The TAKS is a state mandated criterion referenced test which measures grade level skills in reading, mathematics and writing. The tables following list the percent of students who met minimum expectations on the TAKS test.
