

Project Graduation 2010 Information Sheet

At the end when points are closed to tally points and get totals-

For seniors that have **0–5 points** get \$100, **6–10 points** get \$125, **11–15 points** get \$150, **16–19 points** get \$200, **20 points** get a minimum of \$250, then if any is left over, those with 20 points split the remainder (depending if funds are raised for that amount)

To offer an incentive to keep working or participating after you get your 20 points, **every** additional 20 points you make after your first initial points, your name will go into a drawing to win cash prizes or bigger amount prizes. For example if you have 85 points at the end, your name will go in the drawing 3 times.

- ❖ Raise \$25 profit - 1 point.
- ❖ Work 2 hours at a fundraiser - 1 point.
- ❖ Work 1 hour - ½ point.
- ❖ Chair a fundraiser - 3 points. If there is a flyer that will go home with students it will need to be OK'd by Mr. Hayes at the administration building.
- ❖ School spirit- Wear a uniform to promote fundraiser – 1/2
- ❖ Officer – 5 points
- ❖ If a senior has an idea he or she will get ½ point for executing the idea. For example-Design a poster and display at school to promote a fund raising activity. Ideas should be submitted prior to execution.

Anyone can work for a senior to help with points, (mom, dad, grandparents, sister, brother, aunt, uncle, etc.) but the person that works for the senior has to be at least of teenage years. Be sure to sign in at that fundraiser to get credit for working. If you are not working or participating in the fundraiser you signed in for, you could possibly lose those points for not helping out. It is your choice to work, and it is strictly volunteering, but when you sign-in to work a fundraiser, it is your responsibility to help.

You don't have to work every fundraiser. We will be doing fundraisers all year, so pick and choose what you want to do. Don't get burned out. There is a lot to do and **WE NEED YOU!** Everything and Anything anyone does is very much appreciated. Thank you for your help and support!!!
